The 2019 Seasonal Camping Agreement has been mailed

Please note of the dates listed below:

August 24, 2018: Completed Camping Agreement due for 12 Automatic (Direct Debit) withdrawals.

September 7, 2018: If you are paying in full - take advantage of early bird price by Sept. 7. It can be paid with **cash, cheque, debit, or credit card.** If you notify the office by Sept. 7 that you are leaving the park, you can remain until the end of the 2018 season.

Winterizing must also be paid by Sept. 7 for the early bird rate.

October 12, 2018: After Sept. 7, the early bird price is no longer available and must be paid in full by Oct. 12.



New Lake Buoys

Pike Lake and the Social Committee together have purchased a new buoy line at the beach to set a designated swimming area for our residents and guests of all ages. We have put the buoys in so the beach area can be enjoyed safely; we ask that swimmers respect the purpose of the buoy line and help to preserve them by staying off - they are not a toy but a boundary line.

ANY boats (pontoons, kayaks, canoes, etc.) seen within the perimeter of the buoy line will be removed from the lake and will not be permitted to return.

Swimming in the lake remains at your own risk whether swimming inside or outside the boundary line. Children under 12 swimming in the lake must be supervised by a responsible adult. Please report unsupervised children to the Office so we can assist in finding their parents.

Report any noticed malfunctions such as rips and tears to the inflatable water park items, and broken beach chairs. Please put chairs back on the beach when you are no longer using them, do not leave them in the lake.

Golf Cart Safety

Under the Ministry of Transportation guidelines, the use of golf carts is restricted to PEOPLE HOLDING A VALID ONTARIO DRIVERS LICENSE. Absolutely no one without a valid driver's license may drive. **We are receiving reports of an alarming amount of youth driving golf carts, if we find youth driving carts, the cart keys will be immediately taken and the golf cart will be removed from Pike Lake at the cart owner's expense.**

We must also remind our Occupants and guests they must still abide by all normal traffic signs and laws of the road under the Highway Traffic act when driving through the campground. This includes NOT allowing toddlers and children to sit on adult's laps in the drivers seat of a vehicle, or hang out the back of open trunks. We have witnessed incidences within the campground that could have easily gone much worse, and were entirely preventable.
