August 24, 2018: Completed
Camping Agreement is due if paying by 12 Automatic (Direct Debit) withdrawals.

***NOTE we will not be accepting late agreements to be paid by 12 Automatic withdrawals if they are handed in beyond this date.**

September 7, 2018: If you are paying in full - take advantage of early bird price by Sept. 7.

It can be paid with **cash, cheque, debit, or credit card.** If you notify the office by Sept. 7 that you are leaving the park, you can remain until the end of the 2018 season.

Winterizing must also be paid by Sept. 7 for the early bird rate.

October 12, 2018: After Sept. 7, the early bird price is no longer available and must be paid in full by Oct. 12.
