## End of Season Reminders

- Boats must be moved from the fishing dock by the end of the season. Boats must be stored at the boat owner's site for the winter. This will help us determine unwanted boats and prevent any chance of winter damage from snowmobiles etc. **Any boats that have not been moved from the fishing dock by October 8, 2018 will be moved into winter storage by Pike Lake where there will be a fee for retrieval in the spring.**
- Turn main breaker off inside the trailer
- Disconnect and put away hoses
- Empty and turn off fridge and prop open door
- Unhook and store away water purifiers
- Secure propane tanks
- If Pike Lake is winterizing, put newspaper down on the floor as staff do not remove their work boots.
