COVID-19 Reminders

The lake may be used for swimming and for legal guardians to monitor their children swimming, but the sandy beach area is not open for people to gather and hang out. The beach area can quickly get over crowded and unfortunately physical distancing becomes very difficult to maintain in this relatively small area. For the time being, we are discouraging and limiting areas where groups can gather and social distancing could become an issue.

Continued COVID-19 Restrictions at Pike Lake:

Social distance and limit groups to 10 persons.

This only applies to outdoor gatherings. Our public health inspector informed us it isn't physically possible to maintain 6ft distance between 10 persons (or less) inside a trailer or park model if all people are not from the same household or the same social circle.

The following areas in the park **must remain closed until further notice:**

- Washrooms are closed.
- Laundry rooms are closed.
- Playgrounds are closed and off-limits.
- The pool is closed.
- The rec. hall is closed.
- The back tent and pavilion at the beach are closed and off-limits.

Face Masks in Commercial Buildings Required

Our Public Health Unit (Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph) has issued a class order effective 12:01am June 12, 2020: any customer, patron, employee or visitor who enters a commercial establishment in the WDG region is required to wear a face covering while inside the establishment. A face covering must now be worn in all Pike Lake owned buildings, as well as ALL local businesses. This order is in effect until rescinded by the Medical Officer of Health.
