

House Alcohol Policy

ALCOHOL POLICY

Members and guests are encouraged to use and enjoy our facilities. Pike Lake requires everyone to comply with all of its policies and procedures, and the laws of the Province of Ontario, including all rules and regulations of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission with respect to the service and consumption of alcoholic beverages. In accordance with the Ontario Liquor Laws, **NO** alcoholic beverages, other than those sold by Pike Lake in our licensed premises or from its card on the golf course shall be brought to or consumed on the premises. Pike Lake Management and Staff want our guests to have a very safe and pleasant stay every time they visit our facilities.

Pike Lake's liquor policy is as follows:

Alcohol can be consumed **only** in these licensed locations
Clubhouse including Restaurant, Sunroom, Covered Deck and Patio
Golf Course

Alcohol **is not permitted** in these locations

- Parking Lot
- Driving Range
- Practice Green
- Grassy area next to patio
- Locker rooms, storage areas or hallways

Customers Consuming Alcohol:

- Must be 19 years of age or older to be served
- Required to provide acceptable proof of age and Photo ID upon request by server
- Guests are prohibited from purchasing for or sharing alcoholic drinks with underage guests
- Staff will not serve anyone appearing intoxicated, and Police assistance will be used as needed
- The use of illegal drugs is prohibited by law

All the staff and management are Smart Serve trained in the legal and safe service of alcohol and will intervene to keep all of our customers safe.
