Seasonal Camping Agreement

Seasonal Camping Agreements for 2026 have been emailed out this week. A link within the email redirects you to a form to fill out through our website.

We kindly appreciate you giving this new method a try. We know we had issues last year, but this is a new format and should hopefully be more user friendly.

If you haven't received an email from customerservice@pikelake.com with agreement information, please reach out to the Office so we can fix that for you.

In order to take advantage of early-bird prices, ensure you make payment arrangements by the due dates listed within the agreement. The monthly automatic withdrawal payment method for 2026 camping will NOT be available after August 27, after which payment must be made in full. Only provide a new void cheque if your banking information has changed, if you did not pay in monthly instalments for 2025 or if you were not on direct deposit in August of 2025.

If you are not returning, please notify the office or return the Camping Agreement stating that you are not returning (please note – your season is paid up until October 15, 2025).

Water Ban in Effect

A watering ban is still in place until further notice for the campground as we've seen little-to-no rain. During this time, please refrain from:

- Washing cars, trailers, or other vehicles
- Watering lawns
- Using pressure washers
- Any non-essential outdoor water use

We also ask that you keep plant watering to an absolute minimum.

Your cooperation is essential in helping us protect and preserve our natural resources during this dry period. Let's all do our part—and hope for some much-needed rain soon! Thank you for your understanding and support.

Careful with Campfires

A partial fire ban is in effect for our region. For now, recreational campfires and cooking fires are permitted. With the dry conditions however, we are asking that you take extra precautions with campfires by keeping fires small, under control, and make sure your fire is completely out before you go to bed at night or leave your campsite.


