Seasonal Camping Agreement Reminder!

Seasonal Camping Agreements for 2026 were emailed out last week. A link within the email redirects you to a form to fill out through our website. If you did not receive your 2026 Camping Agreement, please reach out to the main office.

As a reminder, the monthly automatic withdrawal payment method for 2026 camping will **NOT** be available after **August 27**, after which payment must be made in full.

Only provide a new void cheque if your banking information has changed, if you did not pay in monthly instalments for 2025 or if you were not on direct deposit in August of 2025.

To take advantage of the early bird rates, payment in full is due on **August 27**.

If you are not returning, please notify the office or return the Camping Agreement stating that you are not returning (please note – your season is paid up until October 15, 2025).

Water Ban Still in Effect

The watering ban is in place until further notice for the campground. During this time, please refrain from:

- Washing cars, trailers, or other vehicles
- Watering lawns
- Using pressure washers
- Any non-essential outdoor water use

We also ask that you keep plant watering to an absolute minimum.

Your cooperation is essential in helping us protect and preserve our natural resources during this dry period. Let's all do our part—and hope for more rain soon!

Careful with Campfires

A partial burn ban is still in effect for our region. For now, only recreational campfires and cooking fires are permitted. But with these dry conditions, we ask that you take extra precautions with campfires by keeping fires small, under control, and by making sure your fire is completely out before you go to bed at night or leave your campsite.
