IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- **Remember to DRIVE SLOW and with caution! This applies to both personal vehicles and golf carts!**
- Please pick up your golf cart stickers at the main office
- The following buckets are available to purchase:
 - Sand, top soil, gravel, washed stone, stone dust, p-stone, wood, brown mulch
 - Please note: There is no weekend delivery for buckets.
- For those requesting for their lawns to be cut, we suggest checking the PL camper-run Facebook page to see if there are any independent grass cutters
- The laundry machines (washers and dryers both) now take two loonies and three quarters **(\$2.75) per load**

HOW TO ORDER A PROPANE FILL



1. Submit work order with the main office
 - a. You can call, email, or stop by in person
2. If it's a 20lb or 30lb tank, please drop it off outside of the fence across from the office with your lot number printed CLEARLY on the tank
3. If it's a 100lb tank, please make sure that it is unhooked so that Larry can switch it out

*Please note that fills ordered after 1pm on Mondays through Saturdays will not be completed the same day. Additionally, there are no Sunday fills.





Garbage and Golf Cart Regulations

- Please follow the signs to dispose of your waste into either: household waste (garbage), cardboard recycling (please flatten these), general recycling, or electronic waste.
 - Please note that the yellow-lidded green bins are for folded cardboard only.
- Please do not clog up the general recycling with big, empty, unfolded boxes – instead, flatten these and throw them into the cardboard recycling bins
- Larger items (such as old mattresses, sofas, fridges, and BBQs) can either be disposed of at the Harriston dump, or you can call the office to arrange a pick-up for a minimal charge.
- Here at Pike Lake, we take immense pride in our beautiful golf course and campground. To keep our community looking its best, we kindly ask all residents and visitors to dispose of garbage and recycling properly. Thank you!

Please ensure no litter or trash is left behind at your campsite, on the golf course, or in any common areas.

See page 4 for a quick guide of what can and cannot be recycled.

- Only individuals with a valid driver's license (G2 or higher) are permitted to drive a golf cart in the park.
- All cart riders must be seated
- Only two occupants are allowed in the front seats (-- this includes the driver). You may have up to two more occupants in the back, but only if your cart has rear seats.
- Golf carts are not to be driven after dusk unless equipped with working headlights and taillights. Flashlights are NOT an adequate substitute.
 - No one under the age of 21 is to have a golf cart out after dusk.
- Quiet time begins at 11pm. Golf carts should be off the road by this time, or at the very least, solely used to get to and from your trailer – no joyriding.
- **Remember to DRIVE SLOW and with caution! This applies to both personal vehicles AS WELL AS GOLF CARTS!**
- Please pick up your golf cart stickers at the main office
- Numerous cart violations have already been observed this season, which is why repercussions will intensify from now on.

Please be aware that golf cart rules will be heavily enforced. If found in violation of the rules, your cart will be impounded for the remainder of the season.
