

Please note this is the last weekend to sign up for X-mas in July, there will be no exception to this rule as we need to make sure there is enough gifts for the children and they have to be wrapped.



## IMPORTANT REMINDER - E-BIKE, ELECTRIC SCOOTER AND OVERALL BIKE SAFETY

---

As we continue to enjoy a busy and fun-filled summer at the park, we want to take a moment to remind everyone about the **importance of safety when using electric scooters, e-bikes, and bicycles** within the campground.

We've received a number of concerns regarding **young riders not paying attention to traffic and riding at unsafe speeds**. With the volume of vehicle and foot traffic in the park, this creates a serious risk for injury.

Please be reminded of the following:

- **Helmets must be worn** when riding any e-bike, electric scooter, or bicycle.
- Riders must **travel at safe, controlled speeds** and be aware of their surroundings at all times.
- Always **look both ways and yield to traffic** when crossing roads or paths.
- Do not drive bikes into the dark without reflective clothing/lights

Parents — please ensure your children understand and follow these safety rules.

Almost all of the issues brought to our attention involve **young campers riding unsafely while unattended**. While we absolutely love having kids in the park, they must know to be aware of their surroundings — and this ultimately falls to parents and guardians to reinforce. We absolutely do **not** want to see anyone get hurt, and we ask for your full cooperation in keeping the park safe for everyone.

**Please note that in our camping contracts we do note that electric scooters and e-bikes are prohibited from the park. Thus far this has not been enforced, but if these safety concerns continue, we will be forced to enforce this.**

## DOCK BY THE BEACH:

Please be advised that **fishing is strictly prohibited from the dock beside the beach**.

This dock is reserved for those paying to store their boat on the dock and unfortunately, there has been noticeable damage to a boat. This is unacceptable, and as a result, **access to the dock is limited to those who have paid for dock space and will have to be enforced**.

For those wishing to fish, please use either the designated **fishing dock** or the **open grass area adjacent to the bunkies**.

If you notice people fishing off the dock, please notify the office.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in helping us protect campers' property and maintain a respectful environment for everyone.
